## Lyle School Receives \$641,960 Grant With Strings Attached

Lyle Middle School is one of 13 schools that are to receive School Improvement Grants (SIG), according to an announcement by Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), Randy Dorn. But, the dollars come with strings attached. According to a press release by Dorn's office, schools are required to select from one of the following four options:

- Turnaround: Replace the principal, rehire no more than 50 percent of the staff.
- Restart: Convert the school or close and reopen it under a charter school operator, a charter management organization or an education management organization.
- School closure: Close the school and enroll the students who attended that school in other schools in the district that are higher achieving.

• Transformation: Replace the principal, institute comprehensive instructional reforms, increase learning time and provide operational flexibility and sustained support.

According to the release, this is the third group of SIG federal grants. A study by OSPI showed that "three out of every four schools made single or double-digit gains in readings scores," and 95 percent made similar gains in math. The grants are targeted toward schools that are priority schools, defined as being among the lowest 5 percent of Title I schools in the state, based on test scores.

According to Superintendent of [Lyle](#) school district, Dr. Glenys Hill, the school will receive \$641,960 and has selected option four, transformation. The plan will go into effect almost immediately.

According to Hill, the [Lyle](#) School Leadership Team, which consists of staff, faculty, administrators and the public developed a plan and began to work on the application for the grant last September. The goals were to "fully align the curriculum with state standards," says Hill. Key parts of the plan are:

- hire literacy and math coaches,
- have targeted interventions and assessment to support students during and after school,
- have a person assigned to help get chronically absent students to school,
- hire a liaison to build bridges with the Native American students,
- operate a summer school,
- provide staff training.

Hill said she will be leaving her position at end of this school year. The new superintendent will have the title of superintendent/principal of grades 6-8. Phil Williams, the current principal of k-12 will remain as principal of k-5 and 9-12.

The school will receive \$333,500 immediately for this summer and next school year. They will get another \$195,160 next year and \$113,300 in the final year of the grant. Hill was the primary author of the grant application. She has been serving as the superintendent since 2012, overseeing recovery of the school, which was on probation. Interviews for a new superintendent are being held this month.
