Book Review

Garth Stein, author of the bestseller "**The Art Of Racing In The Rain**", has written a stunning new novel of forgiveness and redemption set in the Pacific Northwest.

In 1990, fourteen year old Trevor Riddel gets his first glimpse of the legendary family mansion constructed of giant whole trees and set on a huge estate overlooking Seattle's Puget Sound. It was built from the spoils of a massive timber fortune gained by clear cutting whole forests by his great grandfather, the iron willed Elijah Riddel. Trevor's bankrupt parents have begun a trial separation and his father, Jones Riddel, has arrived at the mansion to join forces with his sister, Serena, to dispatch their father, Trevor's Grandpa Samuel Riddel, to a nursing home, leaving them free to sell off the house and property to be developed, divide the profits and live happily ever after.

But as Trevor explores the house's secret stairways and hidden rooms, he discovers a spirit lingering in the house that is at odds with the family plan. Only Trevor's willingness to face the dark past of his forefathers will reveal the key to his family's future.

Rich with scenes of transcendent natural beauty, unconventional characters and unforgettable moments of emotional truth, this is a triumphant work by a master storyteller at the height of his power. This book reached out and grabbed me from the first chapter. I know you will find it just as engrossing as I did.

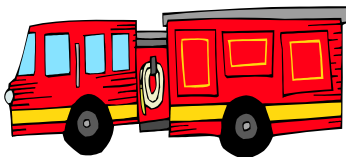
