Book Review

House Broken by Sonja Yoerg

In this compelling and poignant debut novel, a woman skilled at caring for animals must learn to mend the broken relationships in her family....

For veterinarian Geneva Novak, animals can be easier to understand than people. They're also easier to forgive. But when her mother, Helen, is injured in a vodka-fueled accident, it's up to Geneva to give her the care she needs.

Since her teens, Geneva has kept her self-destructive mother at arm's length. Now, with two slippery teenagers of her own at home, the last thing she wants is to add Helen to the mix. But Geneva's husband convinces her that letting Helen live with them could be her golden chance to repair their relationship.

Geneva isn't expecting her mother to change anytime soon, but she may finally get answers to the questions she's been asking for so long. As the truth about her family unfolds, however, Geneva may find secrets too painful to bear and too terrible to forgive.

This was a compelling story that dealt with the struggle of families to understand each other and even more, to love each other anyway, in spite of all the flaws and mistakes. I loved that nobody was perfect and that they just kept on trying. This was a great read.

"Jeff Hunter, Klickitat Co. Public Works spoke about the process of developing the Firearms Facility near the intersection of Hiways 197 and 14. The Facility is being developed by the County to provide a safe shooting venue for the Gorge. Archeology and cultural resource studies have been completed with lead and noise studies planned for completion in the next few weeks. Then the SEPA process, which provides opportunity for public comment, will be started for completion in late summer. Mr. Hunter said there would be public meetings in the area to listen to concerns and questions about the facility. Watch for notice of the meetings in local media."

KCSO To Open West Side Office

Klickitat County Sheriff Bob Songer has announced that the sheriff's office will staff a new office in White Salmon. "I have decided in order to better serve our citizens on the west end of the county, I will be committing personnel to the [Klickitat County Sheriff's](#) West End Office at the Pioneer Center in White Salmon two days each week," Songer stated in a letter addressed to the citizens of the county. The West End office will be open Wednesday and Thursday each week from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. beginning June 3. Songer says the office will help west-side residents in acquiring weapons permits and other law enforcement business.

Spring Chinook season opened May 23 on White Salmon River, June 1 on Klickitat River

New permanent rules recently adopted during the game fish and North of Falcon salmon regulation processes take effect May 23 for the White Salmon River and June 1 for the Klickitat River.

Spring Chinook strays have been found in the White Salmon River system prompting changes that open an additional three miles of river to fishing for salmon. Effective May 23 through July 31, White Salmon River anglers will be allowed to fish for hatchery spring Chinook from the county bridge below the former power house upstream to the Northwestern Road Bridge. Through June 30, the daily limit is two hatchery Chinook or hatchery steelhead or one of each.

Effective July 1, the hatchery salmon/steelhead daily limit will be three fish of which no more than two may be hatchery spring Chinook. Salmon minimum size is 12 inches. Wild Chinook and wild steelhead must be released. Release all gamefish except hatchery steelhead. Under new rules for trout, including hatchery steelhead, the season opens June 1 on the Klickitat River. The daily limit of hatchery steelhead will be increased to three fish on the lower Klickitat River from the mouth upstream to Fisher Hill Bridge. The limit for salmon on upper and lower Klickitat River is six hatchery Chinook of which no more than two may be adults.

Up to two hatchery adult spring Chinook may be kept as part of the daily limit for salmon on the upper Klickitat River, which stretches from 400 feet upstream of number 5 fishway (about a half-mile upstream from Fisher Hill Bridge) to the boundary markers below the Klickitat Salmon Hatchery and from the boundary markers above the hatchery to the Yakama Reservation boundary.

In other action, it was announced that Drano Lake anglers may retain up to three hatchery adult spring Chinook from May 17 through June 30, as broodstock goals have been met.

This applies to downstream of markers on the point of land downstream and across from Little White Salmon National Fish Hatchery and upstream of the Highway 14 Bridge. The reason for action is that hatchery returns have been strong to date. The hatchery brood stock goal has been met and surplus hatchery fish are available for harvest. The salmon/steelhead daily limit is a 3 hatchery Chinook or hatchery steelhead of which no more than 2 may be hatchery steelhead. Salmon minimum size is 12 inches. Release wild Chinook and wild steelhead.
