Book Review

"Orchard House"
by Tara Austen

Peeling paint, stained floors, vined-over windows, a neglected and wild garden—Tara Austen Weaver can't get the Seattle real estate listing out of her head. Any sane person would have seen the abandoned property for what it was: a ramshackle half-acre filled with dead grass, blackberry vines, and trouble. But Tara sees potential and promise—not only for the edible bounty the garden could yield for her family, but for the personal renewal she and her mother might reap along the way.

So begins Orchard House, a story of rehabilitation and cultivation—of land and soul. Through bleak winters, springs that sputter with rain and cold, golden days of summer, and autumns full of apples, pears, and pumpkins, this evocative memoir recounts the Weavers' trials and triumphs, detailing what grew and what didn't, the obstacles overcome and the lessons learned.

Inexorably, as mother and daughter tend this wild patch and the fruits of their labor begin to flourish, green shoots of hope emerge from the darkness of their past.

For everyone who has ever planted something that they wished would survive—or tried to mend something that seemed forever broken—Orchard House is a tale of healing and growth set in a most unlikely place.

This is such an uplifting story. I loved reading about the garden improvements, the harvests, and the growth of this wonderful, struggling family. What a great book!

Heat Exhaustion

Heavy sweating
Weakness
Cold, pale, and clammy skin
Fast, weak pulse
Nausea or vomiting
Fainting

What You Should Do:

Move to a cooler location.
Lie down and loosen your clothing.
Apply cool, wet cloths to as much of your body as possible.
Sip water.
If you have vomited and it continues, seek medical attention immediately.

Heat Stroke

High body temperature (above 103°F)*
Hot, red, dry or moist skin
Rapid and strong pulse
Possible unconsciousness

What You Should Do:

Call 911 immediately — this is a medical emergency.
Move the person to a cooler environment.
Reduce the person's body temperature with cool cloths or even a bath.

New Superintendent/Principal

The Lyle School District Board of Directors is thrilled to announce that Andrew Kelly has accepted the position of K-12 Superintendent/Principal.



The Lyle School District hosted Andrew E. Kelly (Andy) on Sunday, June 14 and Monday, June 15, as their finalist candidate to lead the Lyle School District beginning in the 2015-16 school year. On June 18, in their regular board meeting, the board affirmed the decision, unanimously, to hire Kelly as their Superintendent beginning July 1, 2015.

Kelly met with staff, students, school board, and a hosted community forum over the two days to answer questions about his vision to work with staff and community stakeholders to ensure that Lyle School District is an exceptional school district for the students they serve. Kelly was peppered with and responded to questions about building relationships, curriculum, discipline, and the complexities of helping Lyle move from its current “Priority” status as defined by OSPI (Office of Superintendent and Public Instruction) and the Federal Government to a high achieving school district that ensures equality in outcomes for all their children.

Kelly challenged all audiences to begin to believe that Lyle can and should “be the highest performing district in the State of Washington.”

School Board Chair, Tria Bullard stated, “Andy’s background, specifically as a high school principal for 17 years and most recently overseeing all of the SIG (School Improvement Grant) schools in the state, makes him the perfect candidate to support Lyle on its journey from a SIG school to becoming a school of distinction. His courageous leadership and vision for the district have inspired us all as we dream together for a brighter future for our students!”

Kelly knows both OSPI and school improvement well. For the past three years, Superintendent Kelly has served the Washington State Superintendent of Public Instruction, Randy Dorn. Dorn recruited Kelly three years ago to lead Washington’s turnaround efforts statewide. In the past three years, Kelly has directed over 280 schools, statewide, holding over 250,000 students and the schools he has supported have dramatically improved. The SIG/RAD schools in Washington State (Lyle Middle School is part of SIG cohort 3) have met or outpaced the entire nation in improvement. The four lowest performing schools in the state, designated “RAD” (Required Action District) have all exited status and are no longer low performing.

Prior to his work at OSPI, Kelly worked as a turnaround high school principal in three different communities in three different states; Procter R. Hug High School in Reno, Nevada, Roosevelt High School in Portland, Oregon, and Clover Park High School in Lakewood, Washington. Kelly began his career as a music teacher. He holds a MA in Educational Administration from Heritage University in Toppenish, WA, and his BA in Music Education from Central Washington University. As part of his continued professional growth, Kelly is enrolled at Washington State University and will begin his superintendent credential/doctorate program in August. When asked about his goals for the district, Superintendent Kelly shared, “my belief is that it is my moral obligation to ensure that every single student in the Lyle community graduates from high school prepared for college, career and beyond. Our kids deserve better and we as a school and community can do better on their behalf!”

The Lyle School District will host a welcome back reception for students and families and formally introduce Kelly to the community this fall—date to be announced. Kelly can be reached at Andrew.kelly@lyleschools.org
