## Lyle Community Schools Honors School Board for Bold Leadership

Governor Jay Inslee has proclaimed January as School Board Recognition Month. This marks the 22nd year of the annual observance initiated by the National School Boards Association in 1995.

School board members are unpaid elected community members who play a crucial role in developing policies and making tough decisions on complex educational and social issues impacting their communities, and the entire state. They are also directly accountable to the citizens in their districts, serving as a vital link between members of the community and their schools.

Lyle Schools' five directors oversee a 176-mile district loosely made up of the communities of Appleton, Klickitat Heights, High Prairie, Dallesport and Lyle. Board Chairperson Tria Bullard and board members Barbara Mills, Adrian Bradford, Phil Williams, and Mark Vorce represent our local citizens, and bring backgrounds from a broad cross-section of the community's major industries, including agriculture, transportation, education, personal services and the tech industry.

All five stepped into their roles during a period of declining enrollment and financial difficulties for the district. Among the most challenging decisions for

the board was the closure of Dallesport Elementary and the unification of all grades on the Lyle campus. The move appears to have paid off. Students, parents and staff are positive about the unification, and reduced operating costs have resulted in additional funding for student programs.

The Dallesport facility is being actively rented by sports organizations for practices in the gym. In addition, discussions are taking place with local/regional government and education leaders regarding the development of a post-secondary education extension site in the school.

The end result should be a vibrant education hub for the Dallesport community and an income stream for the district.

"The Lyle Schools Board of Directors deserves a tremendous



amount of credit for their bold leadership in a time of insufficient resources in Washington State,"

Superintendent Andrew Kelly noted, continuing, "Lyle Schools is quickly becoming a model rural/remote school district for

our entire state. We owe the board and our district educators, as their extension, a huge amount of gratitude."

In November, **Board Chair Tria Bullard and board member Barbara Mills** joined Superintendent Andrew Kelly to give a well-attended presentation on how the district has achieved its recent academic gains at the Washington State School Directors; Association (WSSDA) statewide meeting in Spokane. They presented to a packed house during their session, and were proud to share the growth that has occurred in the district. WSSDA is the largest organization of elected officials in Washington



and includes all of the school board members who serve the state's 295 school districts educating 1.1 million students statewide.

Lyle Schools is proud to join school districts across the state in honoring their local school boards and publicly thank board members for their hard work. The Governor's proclamation has been posted online on the WSSDA website at <http://bit.ly/2hL4Kr1>.

“The Wrong Side of Goodbye”

by Michael Connelly

Only Harry Bosch can uncover LA's darkest secrets in this new gripping thriller from global best seller Michael Connelly.

'What do you want me to do?' Bosch asked again.

'I want you to find someone for me,' Vance said. 'Someone who might not have ever existed.'

Harry Bosch is working as a part-time detective in the town of San Fernando outside of Los Angeles when he gets the invitation to meet with the ageing aviation billionaire Whitney Vance. When he was 18, Vance had a relationship with a Mexican girl called Vibiana Duarte, but soon after becoming pregnant she disappeared.

Now, as he reaches the end of his life, Vance wants to know what happened to Vibiana and whether there is an heir to his vast fortune. And Bosch is the only person he trusts to undertake the assignment.

Harry's aware that with such sums of money involved, this could be a dangerous undertaking - not just for himself but for the person he's looking for - but as he begins to uncover Vibiana's tragic story and finds uncanny links to his own past, he knows he cannot rest until he finds the truth.

This author writes excellent books and Harry Bosch is a complex character. One of my favorite series.

The M&O levy will not raise your taxes. It's a replacement levy for the one that expires this summer. It will allow the school district to perform some badly-needed maintenance that has been put on hold for lack of funds over the years. And it will enable the school district to retain the recently restored career & tech, art, and music teachers, as well as the para-professional aides who are present in every elementary class. Programs and classes were also added back into the curriculum: foreign language, drama and curriculum improvements, and the pre-school program.

If the levy fails, the worst-case scenario would be for Lyle Schools to eventually close. That would be tragic for many reasons, but even with the school closing, we wouldn't be saving any money, because we would inherit the taxes funding the schools of whatever district would absorb Lyle's students.

## Lyle School Levy....Election February 14<sup>th</sup>.

On **February 14**, Lyle Schools will have a renewal maintenance and operations levy on the ballot. We want our voters to make an informed decision and will be sharing facts about the levy here on our Facebook page between now and February 14.

What does the local maintenance and operations (M&O) levy mean to Lyle Schools?

In our current school year, 19 percent of our budget is made up of local levy dollars. Another way to think of it – nearly \$1 out of every \$5 we spend on day-to-day expenses comes from our local levy.

The levy allows us to provide enough staff to provide music, art, and career and technical education classes, plus a support staff for a high-needs student population.

Personnel costs make up about 90 percent of our total \$4 million budget. Without the local levy, we could not provide many programs our kids need and our community values.

Because of changes in state-provided funding, the proposed levy, if approved, will make up \$1 out of \$4 we spend next year.
